MERRILL CREEK CONSERVATION & SPORTSMEN ASSOCIATION Guest Pass Regulations

- 1. Guest passes are available at the MCR Visitors Center weekdays between 8:30 and 4:30, and weekends between 10:00 and 4:00. Hunting is permitted on MCR licensed property Monday through Saturday and five (5) guest passes per day are available.
- 2. An *Application for Guest Pass* form must be filled out in full by the guest or the member and then signed by <u>both</u>. The member's signature attests to the fact that he/she witnessed the guest's signature and that both member and guest are fully aware of all Guest Pass regulations.
- 3. After the *Application for Guest Pass* form is completed and received at the Visitors Center, the guest will be issued an identification button, automobile tag and wildlife questionnaire which can be picked up by either the member or the guest.
- 4. The guest must wear the identification button at all times while hunting on MCCSA licensed property. If the guest's vehicle is used, the automobile tag must be placed in the windshield of the guest's vehicle.
- 5. The member must accompany the guest at all times while hunting on MCCSA licensed property. Members accept total responsibility for their guests.
- 6. Immediately after hunting, the identification button, automobile tag and questionnaire must be returned to the Visitors Center. If the Visitors Center is closed, the materials should be returned the following day unless other arrangements are made with Visitors Center staff.
- 7. Guest Passes are distributed on a first-come, first-served basis. Guest Passes can be reserved up to two (2) days prior to issuance by calling the Visitors Center at (908) 454-1213. Each member is entitled to request a Guest Pass two (2) times per club year. Each guest is limited to using the Guest Pass two (2) times per club year.
- 8. With the exception of members' children, all guests must be 18 years of age or older.
- 9. Prior to the start of the hunting year, members must complete an *Application for Guest Pass* form for their children under the age of 18 to hunt. Children under the age of 18 will not be issued Guest Pass identification buttons, vehicle tags or wildlife questionnaires. Children must be accompanied at all times by the parent member while hunting on MCCSA licensed property.
- 10. No Guest Passes will be issued on the first and last days of shotgun deer season.
- 11. Guests may use only portable tree stands unless given permission by a member to use his/her permanent tree stand.
- 12. Should a member and/or guest violate any of the MCR Rules & Regulations, Operating Rules or Bylaws which govern the MCCSA, and/or the requirements as set forth in the MCCSA License, the member will be subject to disciplinary action as outlined in the Bylaws, Operating Rules, and/or License, and the guest will be banned from future hunting on MCR property.
